

POST RESULTS SERVICES GCSE SUMMER 2026

We hope that you are happy with your examination results, but if there is something that you would like to review or check then there are 3 options available through the post results service. You might decide to see a copy of your exam paper, ask for a clerical re-check or a review of marking. You can challenge a grade or the result of a qualification if you think there has been a mistake.

Access to Scripts (ATS): This is a copy of the marked exam paper that you can use to decide whether to request a review of marking or clerical re-check. The final deadlines to request your marked GCSE exam papers through the ATS service depend on the type of copy you require:

Priority Copy: Wednesday 02 September 2026. If you need a quick copy of your marked paper to help you decide whether to request a formal review of marking or clerical re-check.

Standard Copy: Wednesday 14 October 2026. If you want the paper back purely to support future learning or personal revision.

All access to scripts requests are free of charge, other checks and reviews incur a cost.

Clerical re-check: This is an administrative check of an exam paper. It ensures no pages or questions were missed during marking, all marks were totalled correctly, and the recorded total matches the result on your slip. It **does not** involve a re-evaluation of the quality of your answers.

A clerical re-check is typically requested to rule out simple human or system errors in the grading process.

Review of marking: This is where an exam board senior examiner checks your exam script to ensure the original marker correctly and consistently applied the mark scheme. It is not a complete re-mark from scratch, but a quality assurance check for errors.

The following information explains what may happen if you do request a clerical re-check or a review of the original marking and then a subsequent appeal, for your examinations after your subject grade has been issued.

If the School submits a request on your behalf, there are three possible outcomes:

- Your original mark is lowered, so your final grade **may** be lower than the original grade you received.
- Your original mark is confirmed as correct, so there is no change to your grade.
- Your original mark is raised, so your final grade **may** be higher than the original grade you received.

To proceed, you must complete the online forms clearly stating the exams that you wish for the School to apply for either a clerical re-check or a review of marking. You can find the exam codes are on second page of this document.

The deadline for submission to the Exams Officer is Friday 18 September 2026.

Your request must be accompanied by the correct payment, sent via ParentPay. If you are applying for post results services after 01/09/2026 and you are no longer a student at Tonbridge Grammar School then payment must be made via bank transfer to Tonbridge Grammar School, sort code 30-98-63, account 00085251. Please reference the payment with your candidate number (6***) and the word 'GCSE'.
