



Summary of Examination Performance

TGS remains one of the most academically successful schools in the country and a leading school for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

The School's IB Diploma results reflect the exceptional performance of our students, achieving an outstanding average point score of 36.7; the world-wide average and UK average are 30.26 and 34.04 respectively. Four students achieved 44 points with 35 students (30%) achieving a score of 40 or better and 46% of our students achieving 38 or above. 63% of individual subject grades were at a grade 7 or 6 with the average grade being 5.72.

In a year that was meant to be comparable with pre-pandemic attainment our Year 11 students have improved upon results from 2019 and many measures match or exceed those of 2022; this is a phenomenal achievement. 33% of our GCSE entries were awarded a grade 9 with 16 or our students achieving 10 or more of these top grades. 58% of pupils gained 10 or more 9 -7 grades with 84% achieving 5 or more GCSEs at these top grades. Overall, 59% of all GCSE results were at grade 9 or 8 and 79% at 9, 8 or 7 with the average points per entry of 7.58.
