# Summary of Examination Performance

TGS remains one of the most academically successful schools in the country and a leading school for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

The School's IB Diploma results reflect the exceptional performance of our students, achieving an outstanding average point score of 36.9; the world-wide average and UK average are 30.3 and 34.7 respectively. Two students achieved the maximum 45 points, with three students achieving 44 points, and 31 students (28%) achieving a score of 40 or better and 43% of our students achieving 38 or above. 63% of individual subject grades were at a grade 7 or 6 with the average grade being 5.8.

Our 2024 GCSE cohort have exceeded our aspirational expectation that we would match our phenomenal 2023 GCSE results and this is testament to the hard work and dedication of this exceptional year group. 34% of our GCSE entries were awarded a grade 9 with 14 of our students achieving 10 or more of these top grades. 67% of pupils gained 10 or more 9-7 grades with 89% achieving 5 or more GCSEs at these top grades. Overall, 62% of all GCSE results were at grade 9 or 8 and 82% at 9, 8 or 7 with our average grade at 7.72.
