## Summary of Examination Performance

TGS remains one of the most academically successful schools in the country and a leading school for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme

Two of our students achieved the maximum score of 45 points in the IB Diploma. This accolade is held by 146 students worldwide in 2016. Our average Diploma point score is 37.13 which exceeds the worldwide average of 30.49 TGS students ( $31 \%$ ) achieved a score of 40 or better, 79 students ( $50.6 \%$ ) achieved 38 or above and 112 students ( $71.8 \%$ ) achieved 35 points or more. $68.1 \%$ of individual subject grades were 7 or 6 with the average grade being just below 6 (5.83)

GCSE students also performed exceptionally well this year with 21 students (14\%) gaining 10 or more A*s and 79 students (53\%) gaining 10 or more A or A* grades. Overall, $89.7 \%$ of all GCSE results were at grade $A$ or better. The average points per entry attained of 7.5 is the equivalent of a strong A grade.

In GCSE Mathematics 140 girls (94.6\%) gained an A or A*, with $100 \%$ gaining a B or above, and in GCSE English Language 141 girls (95.3\%) gained an A or A*. Students also achieved exceptionally high grades in GCSE Science and Modern Foreign Languages with the following figures reflecting the number of A* or A grades in each discipline; Spanish 79 (95.2\%), French 44 ( $97.8 \%$ ), Biology 137 (93.2\%), Physics 137 (93.2\%) and Chemistry 131 (89.1\%)
