Summary of Examination Performance

TGS remains one of the most academically successful schools in the country and a leading school for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme. It was awarded IB School of the Year and State Secondary School of the Year 2014 by The Sunday Times.

Two students achieved the maximum score of 45 points in the IB Diploma, this accolade is held by only 60 students in the UK and 218 worldwide. One student achieved 44 points with 41 students (29%) achieving a score of 40 or better and half of our students achieving 38 or above. Our average Diploma point score was 37 which exceeds the UK average of 35 and the worldwide average of 30. 69% of individual subject grades were at a grade 7 or 6 with the average grade being just below a 6 (5.87).

GCSE results were exceptional, confirming TGS as consistently amongst the top performing schools in the country.

11 students (7%) achieved three grade 9s in the reformed English and Mathematics GCSEs. 18 students (12%) gained 10 or more A*/9/8s and 58 students (37%) gained 10 or more GCSEs at grade A/7 and above. Overall, 82% of all GCSE results were at grade A/7 or better.

Outcomes across the full range of subjects were outstanding but performance in the core subjects of English, Mathematics, the sciences (where every student in the year studied three discrete science subjects) and languages was especially strong.

In Mathematics 133 students (85%) gained a grade 7 or better and there were 119 students (76%) who achieved this in English Language. Students also achieved exceptionally high grades in GCSE Science and Modern Foreign Languages with the following figures reflecting the number of A* or A grades in each discipline; Spanish 65 (90%), French 55 (90%), Biology 135 (87%), Physics 135 (87%) and Chemistry 133 (85%).
