Please note that following consultation we changed the uniform requirement for students who commenced **Year 7** in September 2023.

Students in **Year 9** should continue to wear their pleated tartan skirt and students in **Years 10-11** can choose to wear a pleated or a straight tartan skirt.

All students in **Years 9-11** can continue to wear the red and black PE Kit for the academic year 2024/25 or choose to adopt the uniform stated below when new items are required.

There will be a period of transition to the new uniform requirements below during 2024/25 and the new uniform is required for all students from September 2025.

<b>Day Uniform - Winter/Summer</b>	
<b>Skirt or Trousers</b> <i>(compulsory)</i>	* Mackinlay Tartan pleated skirt. Knee length.
	Plain charcoal grey school trousers. No jeans or fashion styled trousers
<b>Jumper</b> <i>(compulsory)</i>	* V-neck with school crest
<b>Blouse</b>	White collared shirt, either long or short sleeved
<b>Hosiery</b>	Plain black or flesh coloured tights or white ankle socks
<b>Shorts</b> <i>(optional)</i>	<b>Summer Term 5-6 only:</b> Plain grey charcoal tailored school shorts
<b>Footwear</b>	Low heeled, black school shoes. No sling backs, peep-toe, sandals, mules, boots, pumps or canvas shoes. Trainers/sports shoes in any style or material are NOT permitted.
<b>Coats</b>	Practical and warm school coats (not denim or leather). Non-school hoodies are not to be worn in place of a coat. However, students are permitted to wear their TGS PE hoodie to and from school.
<b>Headscarves</b>	Religious headscarves should be plain colours
<b>Accessories</b>	Scarves, gloves, hats, hair bands and hair ties must be plain red, green or black. Religious head coverings should be plain and dark in colour to reflect school regulations.
<b>Jewellery</b>	Stud earrings only can be worn. No other facial piercings are permitted. Necklaces and bracelets can be worn as long as they are not visible or a risk to health and safety. Rings are not to be worn.

<b>Hoodie</b> <i>(compulsory)</i>	® *	Black and green panelled hoodie with school crest (Students may be required to wear their hoodies on school trips and it is permitted to be worn to and from school)
<b>Shorts</b>	®	<b>Plain black</b> (unbranded/no logos): in a style comfortable for your child (black shorts are available from our supplier)
<b>Skort</b>	®	Plain black (unbranded/no logos):
<b>Outerwear</b>		Waterproof top <i>(optional)</i>
		Track suit bottoms: <b>plain black</b>
<b>Socks</b>	®	<b>Plain black</b> knee-length

### **Transitional Uniform Requirements for students in Years 9-11 from September 2024**

Students can adopt uniform from either charts above or below

<b>Day Uniform - Winter/Summer</b>		
<b>Skirt</b> <b>OR</b> <b>Trousers</b>	*	Mackinlay Tartan with 4 pleats (Years 7, 8 & 9), A-line (Years 10 & 11) Knee length.
		Plain black school styled trousers. No jeans or fashion styled trousers.
<b>Jumper</b> <i>(compulsory)</i>	*	V-neck with school badge.
<b>Fleece</b> <i>(optional)</i>	*	Regulation green with embroidered school badge (this item is being phased out but may still be available should you wish to purchase one).
<b>Blouse</b>		White blouse, either long or short sleeved
<b>Polo-neck</b> <i>(optional)</i>		Winter wear: red or white cotton polo neck jumper.
<b>Hosiery</b>		Terms 1-4: with winter uniform plain black or flesh coloured tights or white ankle socks.
		Terms 5-6: with summer dresses flesh coloured tights or white ankle socks.
<b>Summer dress</b> <i>(optional)</i>	*	Terms 5-6: Knee length.

<b>Footwear</b>	Low heeled, black shoes - preferably leather. No sling backs, peep-toe, sandals, mules, boots, pumps or canvas shoes. Trainers/sports shoes in any style or material are NOT permitted.
<b>Coats</b>	Plain, (not shiny), in a suitable colour for school. No leather, denim, plastic, corduroy or fake fur. Fur collars or hood edgings are permitted. Non school hoodies are not permitted to be worn to/from school. However, students are permitted to wear their TGS PE hoodie to and from school.
<b>Accessories</b>	Scarves, gloves, hats, hair bands and hair ties must be plain red, green or black. Religious head coverings should be plain and dark in colour to reflect school regulations
