



Summary of Examination Performance

TGS remains one of the most academically successful schools in the country and a leading school for the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme.

The School's IB Diploma results reflect the exceptional performance of our students, achieving an outstanding average point score of 36.8; the world-wide average and UK average are 30.6 and 35 respectively. 2 students achieved the maximum 45 points, with 6 students achieving 44 points, and 31 students (25%) achieving a score of 40 or better and 44% of our students achieving 38 or above. 65% of Higher Level subject grades were at a grade 7 or 6 (A Level equivalent of A* and A grade using both DfE Performance Points and UCAS Points) with the average grade being 5.82.

Our 2025 GCSE cohort has achieved exemplary results and this is testament to the hard work and dedication of this exceptional year group. 28% of our GCSE entries were awarded a grade 9 with 9 of our students achieving 10 or more of these top grades. 53% of pupils gained 10 or more 9-7 grades with 87% achieving 5 or more GCSEs at these top grades. Overall, 55% of all GCSE results were at grade 9 or 8 and 77% at 9, 8 or 7 with our average grade at 7.5.
